15.69	TO CONSIDER MATTERS RELATING TO AN ASSET OF COMMUNITY VALUE Paper MPC(15)69 previously distributed was received. The Clerk took Members through the report which was fully discussed. The report made the following recommendations: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. To take no further action in relation to the Lindos unless a realistic business partner emerges which might be in the form of a credible community group.2. Council should set up a Steering Group to look at what it should be seeking to provide longer term in terms of community amenities, and how best to provide them. This

would include community consultation and inform the size / shape of any new community facility.

3. The Clerk to make further enquiries as to the indicative costs of constructing a suitably sized village hall with associated parking arrangements on Council owned land.
4. The Clerk to have informal discussions with Suffolk Coastal Planners to see what their view would be in relation to an application for a new village facility on Council owned land. This would need to include discussions with County Highways on access / egress issues.

It was RESOLVED to agree all the recommendations.
