

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984: SECTION 14

**TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING ON PART OF THE C373 STATION ROAD,
THE B1438 MELTON HILL, MELTON ROAD AND THE THOROUGHFARE, MELTON
AND WOODBRIDGE**

From 06/11/2017 for an initial period of 5 days there will be a prohibition of waiting on the following roads:

- the C373 Station Road, Melton;
- the B1438 The Thoroughfare, Woodbridge from the Lime Kiln Quay Road junction with St Johns Street to Melton Hill;
- the B1438 The Thoroughfare, Woodbridge from outside number 95 to the junction with Pytches Road;

Further to traffic monitoring there may also be a prohibition of waiting on the following roads:

- the B1438 Melton Hill, Melton; and
- the B1438 Melton Road, Melton.

This is to be replaced by No Parking at any time. There will be no exceptions.

These measures are to facilitate the Suffolk County Council (Parish of Melton) (A1152 Woods Lane and U3621 Saddlemakers Lane) (Temporary Closure and 7.5 Tonne Weight Restriction) Order 2017 that is operative on 06/11/2017, which is to facilitate construction of new footways, bus stops, access improvements and utility connections for the new housing development, which has previously been advertised.

Access will be available for pedestrians and cyclists.

There will also be an amendment to the Eastbound HGV diversion route stated in the above named Order, which will now be the A12, the B1078, the A12, the B1438, Yarmouth Road, Station Road and no vice versa.

It is intended these measures will operate until 30/11/2017 with a second phase scheduled from 08/01/2018 – 13/04/2018 and an Order will be made to cover the further periods.
