

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984: SECTION 14

### TEMPORARY CLOSURE AND 7.5 TONNE WEIGHT RESTRICTION ON PART OF THE A1152 WOODS LANE AND THE U3621 SADDLEMAKERS LANE, MELTON

Suffolk County Council intends to make an order closing the A1152 Woods Lane, Melton from Bredfield Road to the junction with Hall Farm Road and the A1152 Woods Lane, Melton eastbound carriageway only from the A12 roundabout to the junction with Bredfield Road to facilitate the construction of new footways, bus stops, access improvements and utility connections for the new housing development. Other coordinated works may also take place during this period.

Access will be open for pedestrians and cyclists.

For the duration of this closure there will be a 7.5 tonne weight restriction on the U3621 Saddlemakers Lane, Melton with an exemption for farm and delivery vehicles requiring access only.

The diversion routes will be:

- Light traffic: the A12, Ipswich Road, Cumberland Street, Station Road, Quayside, Lime Kiln Quay Road, The Thoroughfare, Melton Hill, Melton Road and vice versa.
- Eastbound HGV's: the A12, the B1078, the A12, the B1438, Yarmouth Road, The Street and no vice versa.
- Westbound HGV's: The Street, Yarmouth Road, the B1438, the A12 and no vice versa.

It is intended that the closure will operate in the following two phases:

1. from 06/11/2017 – 30/11/2017; and
2. from 08/01/2018 – 13/04/2018

If necessary the order may remain in force for 18 months (or longer if extended by the Minister).
