ANNUAL REPORT ON COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE LEVY FUNDS FOR YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2019

Annual report by Melton Parish Council in relation to Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) monies as required by Regulation 62A of the Community Infrastructure Levy (Amendment) Regulations 2013

Melton Parish Council received 15% of the CIL funds received by Suffolk Coastal District Council from development within the parish that was approved prior to the making of the Melton Neighbourhood Plan in January 2018. Payments to the Parish made on qualifying developments approved since the making of the Neighbourhood Plan are at 25% of the CIL monies received by Suffolk Coastal / East Suffolk. These CIL receipts must be used for:

- (a) the provision, improvement, replacement, operation or maintenance of infrastructure; or
- (b) anything else that is concerned with addressing the demands that development places on an area.
