Electricity Supply/Security Barrier

The electricity supply has been laid between the Pavilion and the gate with a socket at the tennis courts for use during the Fete. Phil has reinstated the grass slightly higher so that when it settles it should be level. Paper REC(19)69.01 relates to the purchase and installation of a security barrier.

Memorial Bench

A new bench, which has been fully funded by a resident, has been placed on the edge of the playing field. The resident has expressed her thanks and gratitude to the Council and the Village Handyperson for facilitating this.

Pavilion

Details of the new pavilion at Framlingham have been distributed to all councillors. The project will be part of the resident consultation process on projects funded by Community Infrastructure Levy and will be discussed at Full Council on the 15th January 2020.

Antisocial Behaviour

The Village Handyperson is frequently having to clear up around the Pavilion - pools of vomit, drug paraphernalia and empty bottles/cans. The local Police have been informed and they have said they will try to visit.

WTYFC

An updated hire agreement has been signed by WTYFC. An outstanding payment for October 2019 has now been received. The club has assured us that they will abide by the agreement and there will be no training in the closed season. Therefore, there should be no football being played in June and July and none during the Fete.

Drainage Ditch

The drainage ditch running behind the zip wire is getting quite overgrown and has some logs in it and will require clearing out. SCL have provided a quote of £105 + VAT to flail down and trim vegetation on both sides and bottom of ditch.
