Thank you for your email and attached letter of the 14th of November.

In answer to your specific bulleted questions, ONR does not regulate matters of schedule or cost. The report you refer to is an internal report within EDF associated with EDF SA in France and particularly Flamanville 3.

The Hinkley Point C nuclear site licence (NSL) holder is NNBSGenCo (HPC) Ltd. currently there is no NSL granted nor indeed applied for in respect of SZC.

Therefore ONR has no comment in regards to this report. As this is a matter for EDF SA and the French regulator, should they have any interest, ONR will not have any role in scrutiny of any associated action plan or its delivery.

With regards to Hinkley Point C specifically and indeed Sizewell C should that project proceed, ONR will continue to apply the UK regulatory framework in a rigorous manner, and with the expectation that the UK licencees learn any lessons from previous EPR projects.
