This report was due to be considered by Full Council on 18 March and is an urgent request from the Gazetteer Office at East Suffolk Council.

REVISED NAMING PROPOSALS FOR THE GAH SITE

Originally the developer proposed one name for both the main access road into and through the development, and also for the cul-de-sacs leading off it. This was "Deben Meadows" and Full Council approved that on 15 January 2020.

There is now a revised request. The Developer wants to pursue the option of 'cul-de-sac' addressing. Therefore Melton Parish Council is requested to consider the following names for the cul-de-sacs within the site:

- The Brooks
- Willowbank
- Deben Place.

These names have been proposed because "the underlying geology of the site suggests an inlet off the Deben, rising to the north west. Willow lined brooks and springs fed this inlet and these features remain on the site. The street names therefore combine these aspects with the former use of the land as water meadow (prior to its reclamation)."

The names would be in addition to Deben Meadows which continues to be the name for the main access road through the site.

Appended to this note is the Developer's plan showing how the new names are to be applied on site.

Councillors are requested to consider and agree these revised naming proposals.
