Recreation Related CIL Project Update

Security Cameras

Three security cameras were installed in July and the costs were paid out of CIL reserves.

Pavilion Project

There has been some progress with this project and an architect has been engaged to produce initial ideas and designs. This should be available at Full Council on 16th September 2020. Further information has been sought from neighbouring Town Councils regarding running costs of providing a public WC.

Tennis Courts

The netting continues to be cut and then patched by the maintenance officer. New fencing will be required at some point and Councillors need to decide what priority to recommend for this project.

Car Park resurfacing

The car park surface is deteriorating and will need resurfacing. It could be undertaken as part of the Pavilion replacement project. Councillors need to decide what priority to give this project.

MUGA replacement

The MUGA surface is deteriorating and is not a true multi games area as the surface is not suitable for a range of different sports. Quotes were sought last year for a replacement that would make it suitable for netball, basketball and football. The basketball net has proved to be extremely popular this summer and so providing a proper court and two basketball nets would be of benefit to the community.
