Noticeboard for Old Maltings Approach

A request was made to Recreation, at their meeting on the 24th March, for a noticeboard to be installed at Old Maltings Approach. The landowner has given permission for the noticeboard to be erected and Cllr Hosking is willing to update the board. Recreation agreed that a noticeboard in this location would be a good idea and asked the Assistant Clerk to investigate options and costs to present to FERM for budget approval.

Most of the existing noticeboards in the Parish are made by Glasdon, however they no longer manufacture these items. Having carried out some research I have found this product which I believe meets the requirements. The standard finish is silver anodised although powder coated colour options are available at an additional cost. The noticeboard is lockable and when opened, the door rises and is held open on gas stays ensuring that the user has both hands free for arranging notices. It takes 21 x A4 sheets (same as existing noticeboards) or there is a slightly smaller board that takes 18 sheets and is marginally cheaper.
