CAR PARK FENCING RENEWAL CONTRACT

At its meeting on 15 April 2021, Finance, Employment and Risk Management (FERM) Committee considered prices for the renewal of the low barrier around the car park following completion of the refurbishment contract. The link to the report is here:

Following discussion Councillors **RESOLVED**:

- To decide to stay with metal fencing for the new field barrier
- To accept the price from Contractor B, subject to (1) the company being responsible for accurately measuring the quantities and lengths required, the Council not accepting any responsibility for any shortcomings, and (2) confirming the price.

Since the date of the meeting Contractor B has revised its price to £5,450 + VAT. The revised price includes an extension at the request of the Council so that (1) the barrier extends to the ditch at the east side and (2) sits clear of the tarmac around the new car park. The contractor has confirmed additionally that as soon as the surfacing contractor has put in the new edging to the tarmac area he will check the measurements again, but that any further changes will not affect the price.

Recommendation

Full Council is requested to confirm the recommendation by FERM Committee to accept the (revised) price from Contractor B.
