PURCHASE OF NOTICE BOARD FOR OLD MALTINGS APPROACH

At its meeting on 15 April 2021 Finance, Employment and Risk Management (FERM) Committee considered a report setting out the cost and design details for a Parish Noticeboard at Old Maltings Approach and asking Members to decide whether or not to recommend the purchase to Full Council. FERM Committee considered the matter following a reference from Recreation Committee who previously thought it would be a good idea.

The minute of the discussion and recommendations by FERM Committee (Minute 21.15.06) reads as follows:

To consider purchase of Notice board for Old Maltings Approach (*referral from Recreation committee*)

The Assistant Clerk introduced her report, which was produced in response to a request made to Recreation Committee. The proposal is for the purchase of a metal notice board to serve the residents in the Old Maltings development. Two options were considered – a 21 sheet size (£845.00) and an 18 sheet version (£622.58). Following discussion **it was RESOLVED** to recommend to Full Council:

- To purchase the larger model
- Additionally to ask for it to be powder coated in Melton green
- To allow a budget of up to £945.00 accordingly
- To charge the purchase to CIL.
