Melton Playing Field Signage

At the previous Recreation meeting it was agreed that a replacement sign at the playing field was required. There was a request to have a board with a mixture of fixed messaging and a pinboard section for temporary notices. Members asked the Asst Clerk to investigate possible options and to confirm the wording that should be included on the board. Some suggested wording is shown below:

Welcome to Melton Playing Field and Burkes Wood

To ensure the enjoyment and safety of those using the facilities please follow these simple rules:

- Keep your dog under control and bag & bin all dog waste
- No cycling in the woods
- No fires or BBQs
- No camping
- No overnight parking
- No flying of drones
- No golf allowed
- Please put your litter in the bins provided

Any clubs, organisations or businesses wishing to use the facilities need to seek permission from the Parish Council first.

History

Burkes Wood, together with the playing fields, were gifted to Melton Parish Council in 1952 by Sir Roland and Lady Burke who lived at Melton Mead. The playing field replaced the Garrod Memorial Playing Field in Dock Lane. The remainder of the woodland, apart from the private grounds, was transferred from East Suffolk Council in 2021.
