## Tree Planting Proposal - Winifred Fison

Transition Woodbridge are proposing tree planting at the approach to Winifred Fison House.



The existing trees are shown on the image as solid dull green. The lime green dots are the proposed planting, which would be grafted walnut either end, with plums in between. Planting distances of at least five metres including distance from present trees. Planting line well back from the kerb but still the driveway side of the foot path. This assumes there are no utilities hidden underground that would alter where the trees could be planted.

An indication of cost - Walnut trees cost about £50 each, plums about £30, including p&p . Costs would be slightly reduced if the trees were collected from Norfolk.

Transition Woodbridge are happy to plant the trees with the usual triangular cages and install a watering rota. They could try to plant them over this winter if that suits although the trees would need to be ordered as soon as possible.
