HELP WITH IMPROVING EFFICIENCY IN YOUR HOME

As part of the project to make some Melton homes warmer, greener and improve efficiency, Melton Parish Council has pulled together this fact sheet to try and help you find your way through the myriad of information about what's available in Grants, subsidies and interest free loans.

Funding is available depending on the type of scheme, the household income and whether you are in receipt of benefits or not. Interestingly, many of the schemes are available to you as a homeowner, tenant or landlord, but of course, improving your home will depend on whether you have permission from the property owner to introduce or make improvements to the property.

Help can be available for both loft and wall insulation but may also be available to replace old boilers, introduce solar panels and repair old windows or doors.

Because of the drive to reduce carbon emissions in the UK to zero by 2050, Central Government has made funds available to local authorities to make improvements and save energy, thereby improving carbon emissions while saving you money and keeping you warmer. In all cases, this will be subject to availability of funds and on occasions your personal circumstances. But not all grants are means tested so do apply if you think you meet the criteria.

We hope you will find this information useful. Melton Parish Council will be keeping an eye on any new initiatives that come along and information on these schemes will be made available via the Council's website.

HOUSEHOLD INCOME LESS THAN £30,000

- Warm Homes Suffolk Grant Improvements of insulation and draft exclusion. Applies to homes with a D, E, F or G energy rating. https://www.warmhomessuffolk.org
- Warm Homes Healthy People Grants for First Time Central Heating. Boiler or heater stopped working? Warm Homes Healthy People can lend you electric heaters and point you in the direction of any grant funding available such as assistance in applying for a local authority renovation or home assistance grant. Do you own or privately rent your property? Warm Homes Healthy People can arrange for an independent surveyor to visit your home and discuss energy efficiency improvements that could make a real difference to your heating bills. - Minor Works Grant a grant of between £500 and £5000 to help with house repairs. In receipt of a means tested benefit. Combined income of no more than £15,000 after deducting housing costs (mortgage, rent and council tax)

a new boiler; If you are replacing a fossil fuel heating system (oil, gas, electric); and the
